The World Tallest Building Now Served by Westinghouse Platform Screen Doors

The Burj Dubai station, which is served by Westinghouse Platform Screen Doors on the Red Line of the Dubai Metro, has gone into services to coincide with the opening of the Burj Khalifa tower.

Burj Khalifa is the tallest man-made structure ever built, at 828 m (2,717 ft). Construction began on 21 September 2004, with the building officially opening on 4 January 2010.

The Burj Dubai station is one of the elevated stations on the Red Line and is 132 metres long and 29 metres wide, with a capacity to handle 11,000 passengers per hour in each direction. The station is expected to be used by about 10,000 passengers a day on weekdays and rise on weekends and holidays to 19,000.

The tower and station opened on the fourth anniversary of the accession of His Highness Shaikh Mohammad Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai.
